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#### **VOLUNTEER AGREEMENT**

We welcome and appreciate your participation as a volunteer with The Prince Albert SPCA Animal Care Centre. We hope your work with us is fulfilling and helpful in your personal growth to further your own goals and objectives. In order to best service the needs of our clients and the animals in our care, it is important that you be responsible as a volunteer. We will place our trust in you as a volunteer and ask you to review and agree to the following volunteer principals:

- 1. I am at least 12 years of age and agree not to have anyone under this age accompany me while I represent The Prince Albert SPCA in a voluntary role. Exceptions will be made on an individual basis and must be approved in advance by Volunteer Services.
- 2. I am aware the staff at the PA SPCA reviews each animal's behavior and medical history prior to making a decision regarding its fate. I understand and respect that the PA SPCA practices euthanasia and if I have questions or concerns I will contact my immediate supervisor or volunteer services.
- 3. I authorize the PA SPCA to collect and retain my personnel information in connection with a voluntary role.
- 4. I will read the volunteer guidelines, attend all training sessions, and perform my duties to the best of my abilities.
- 5. I will uphold my professionalism and act as a positive ambassador when representing the PASPCA during my volunteer shift and within the community.
- 6. I will inform the PA SPCA in the event I am charged or convicted of a criminal offence during my volunteer commitment with the organization.
- 7. I will do my best to fulfill my responsibility and commitment to the PASPCA, and will contact volunteer services if my schedule or plans to volunteer change at any time.
- 8. The PASPCA will not be held responsible for any damages to you or your property caused by the actions of the animals in our care.
